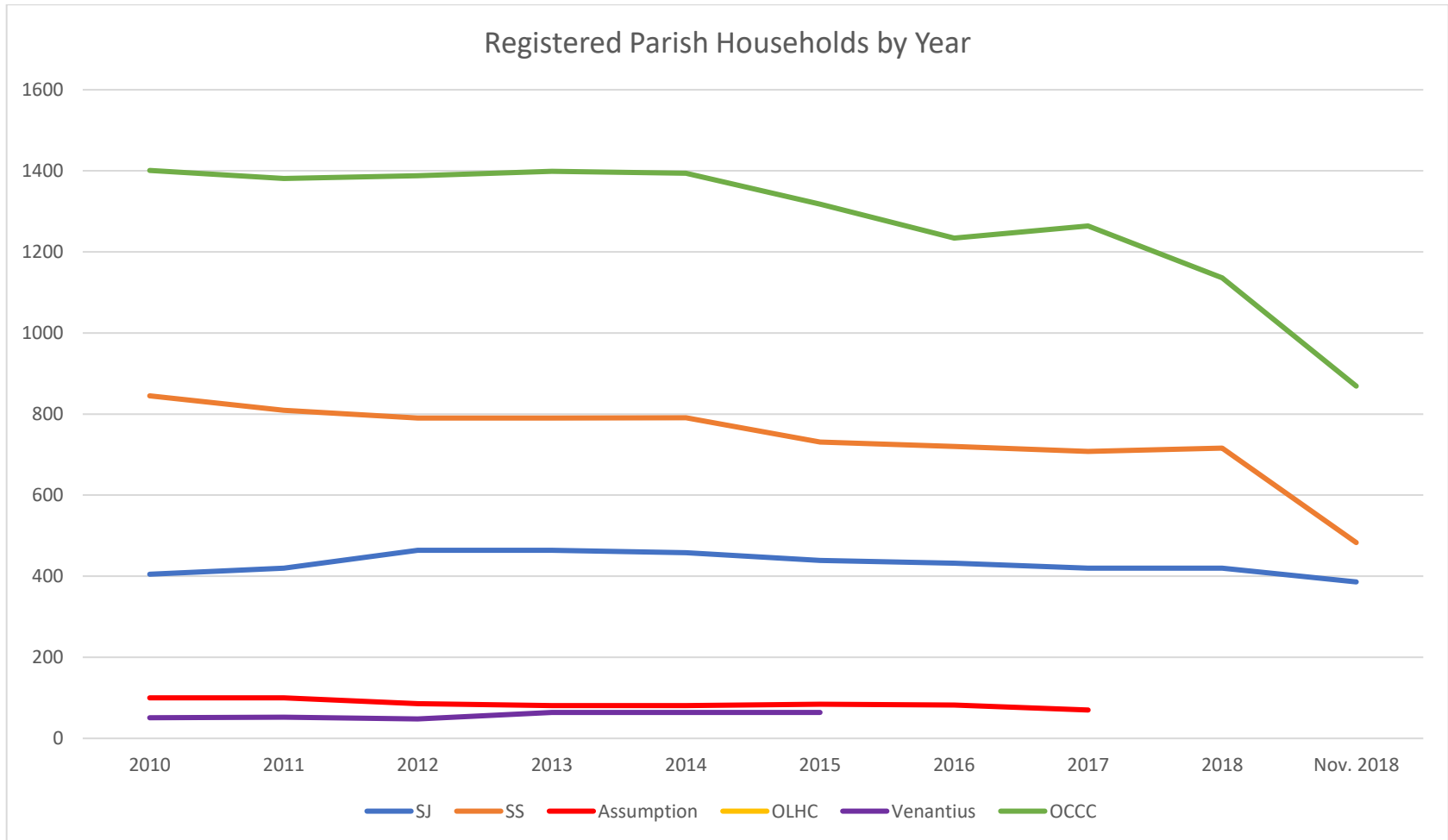


1. Demographic Data

These numbers are taken from the annual report sent to the Diocese by each parish.

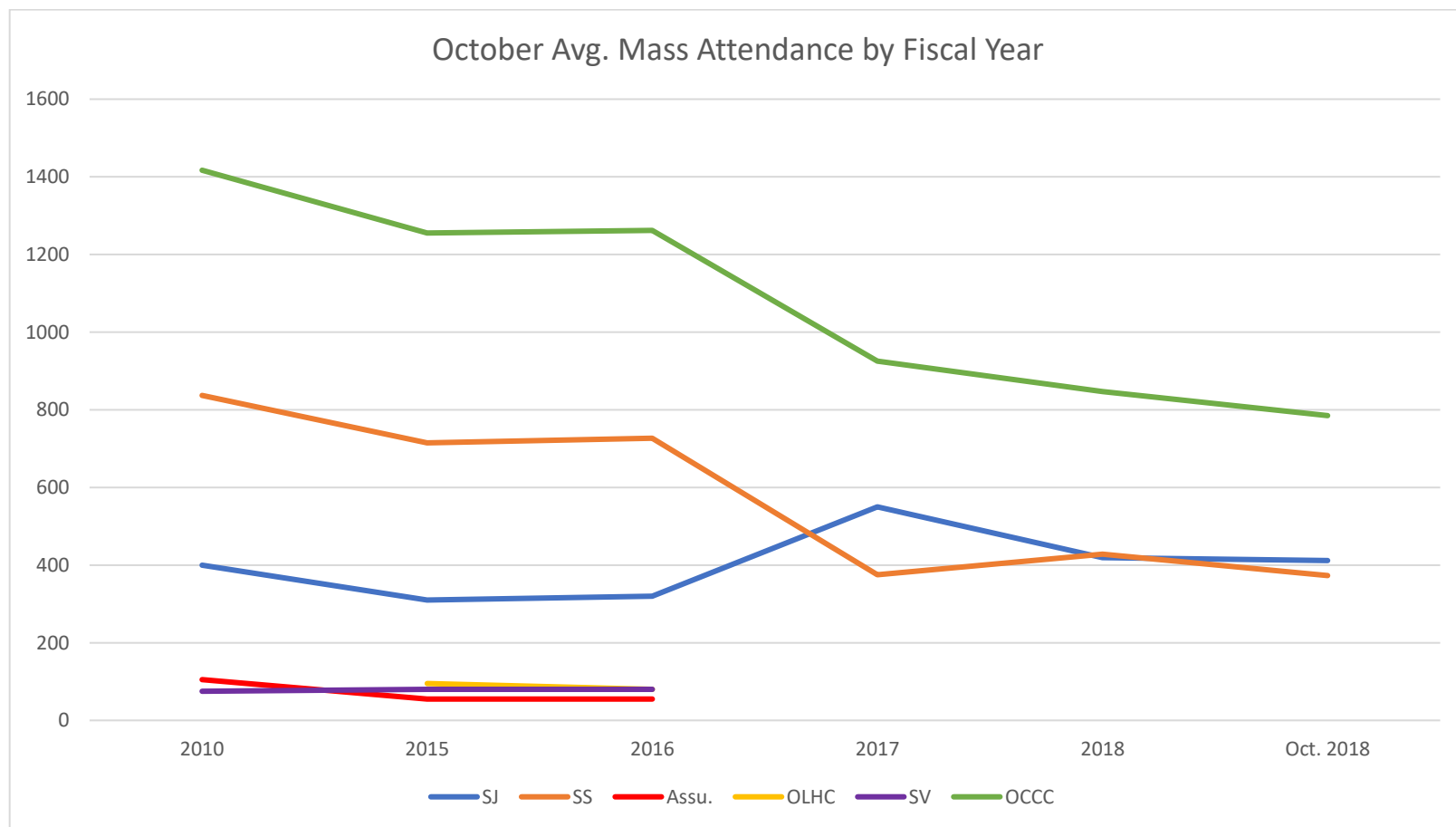
Note: the top line (OCCC) is a total for all extant parishes during a given year.

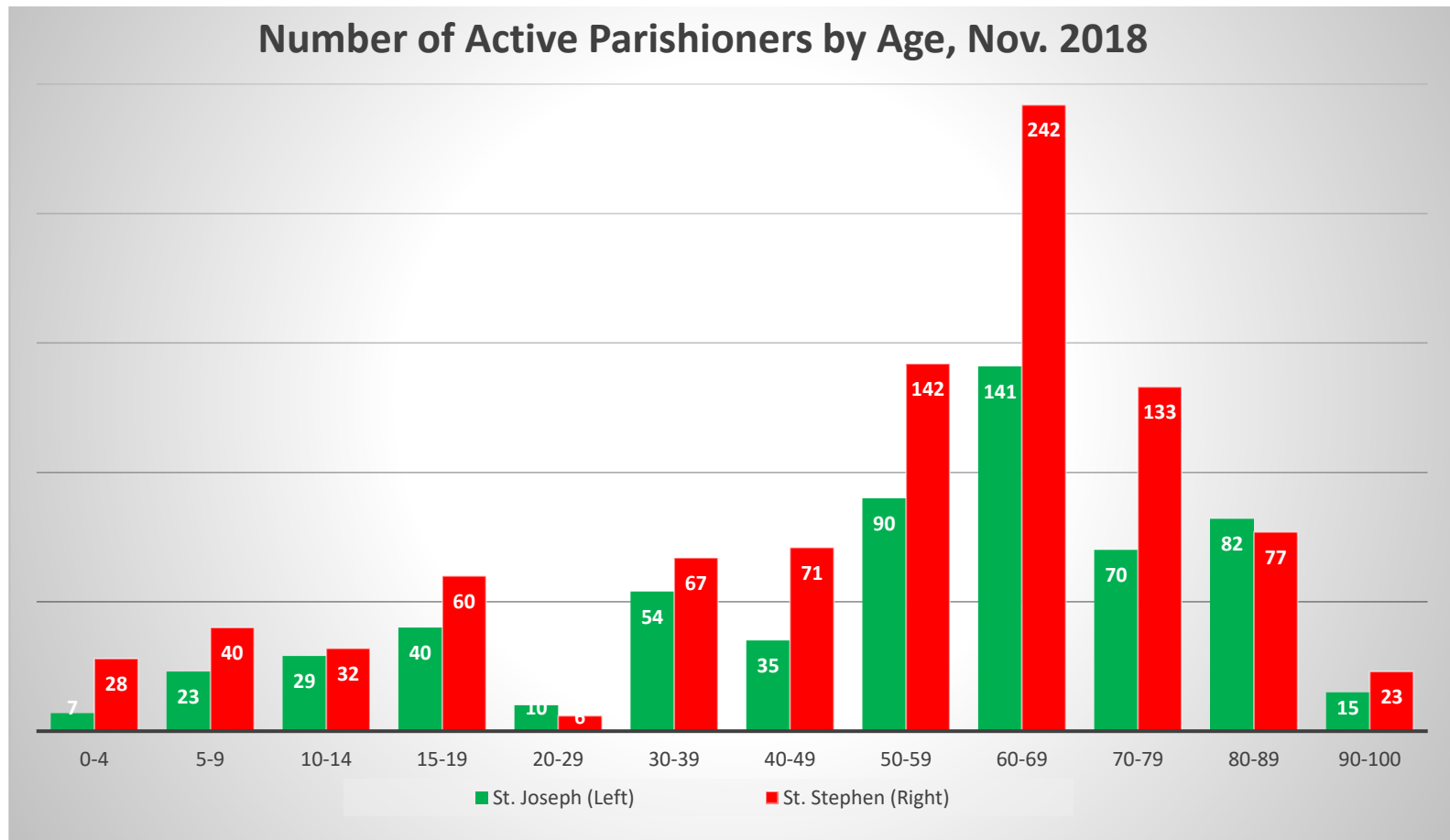

All data is taken from parish electronic files (PDS – Parish Data Systems software) and is current as of Nov. 26, 2018.

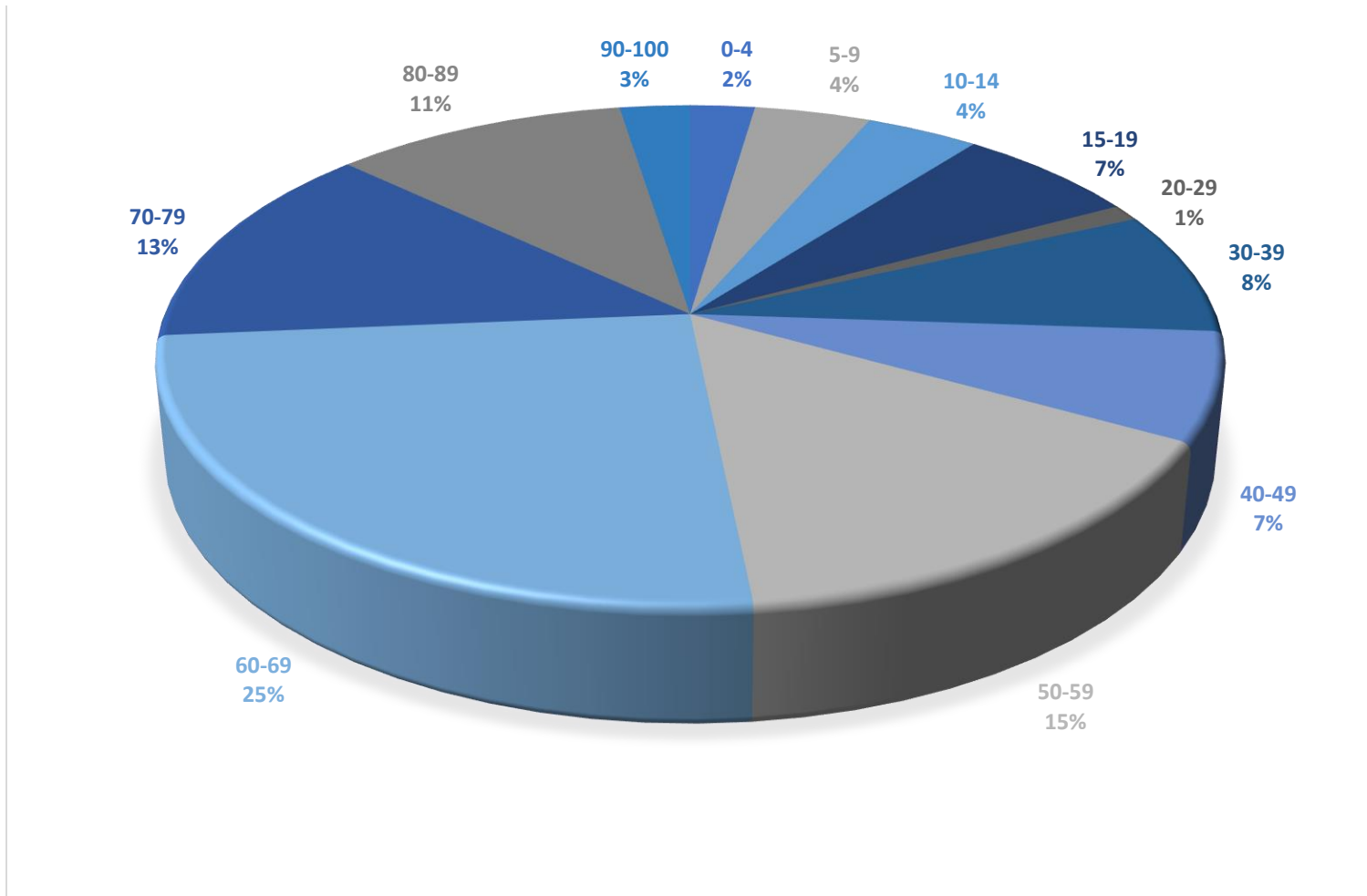
Note: The number of parishioners ages 20-29 was reached by removing from the database count all 20-29 year olds who are listed as dependents and who do not live in the area full time.



1d. Percentage of Active Parishioners by Age

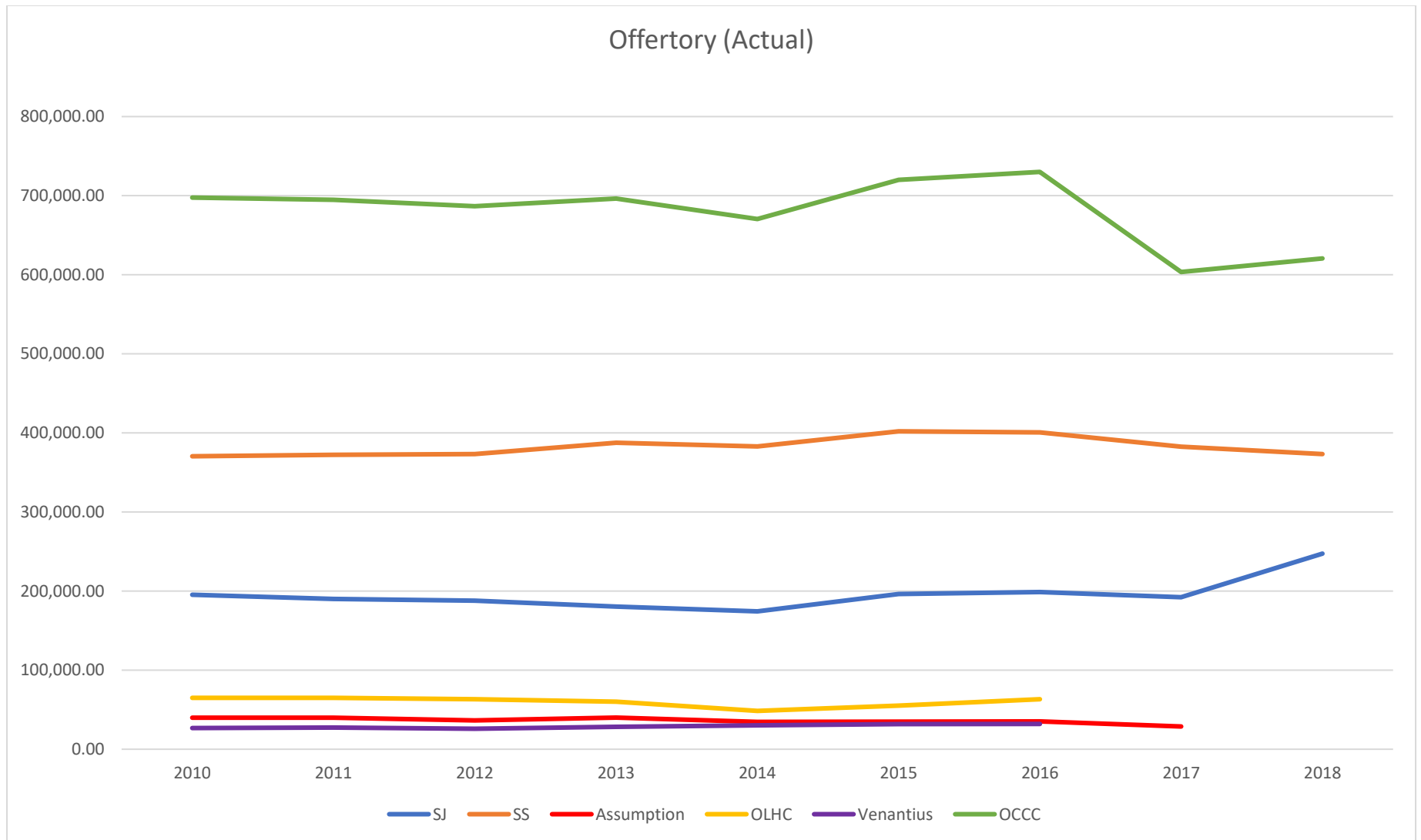

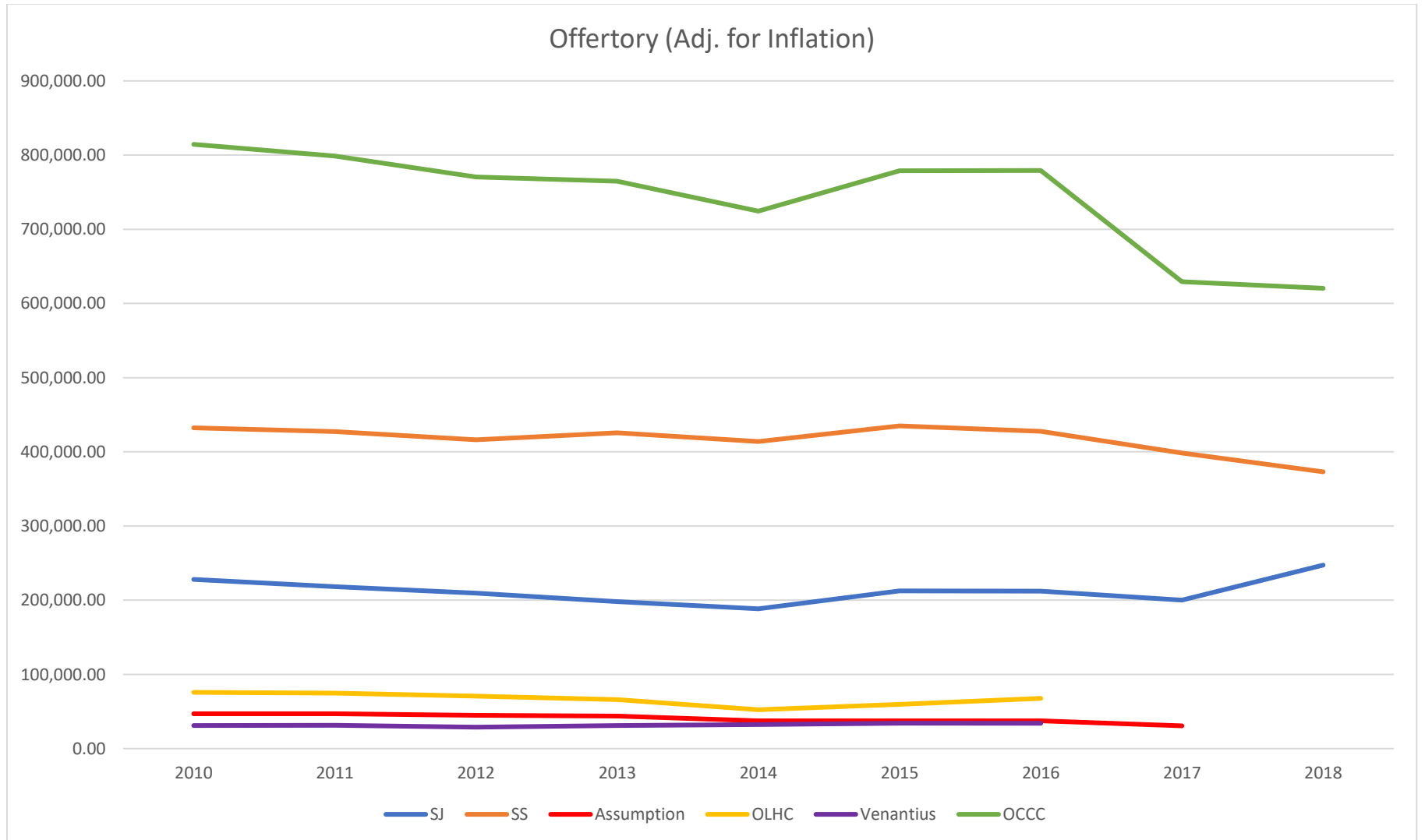

2a. Offertory Income per Parish per Year (Actual)



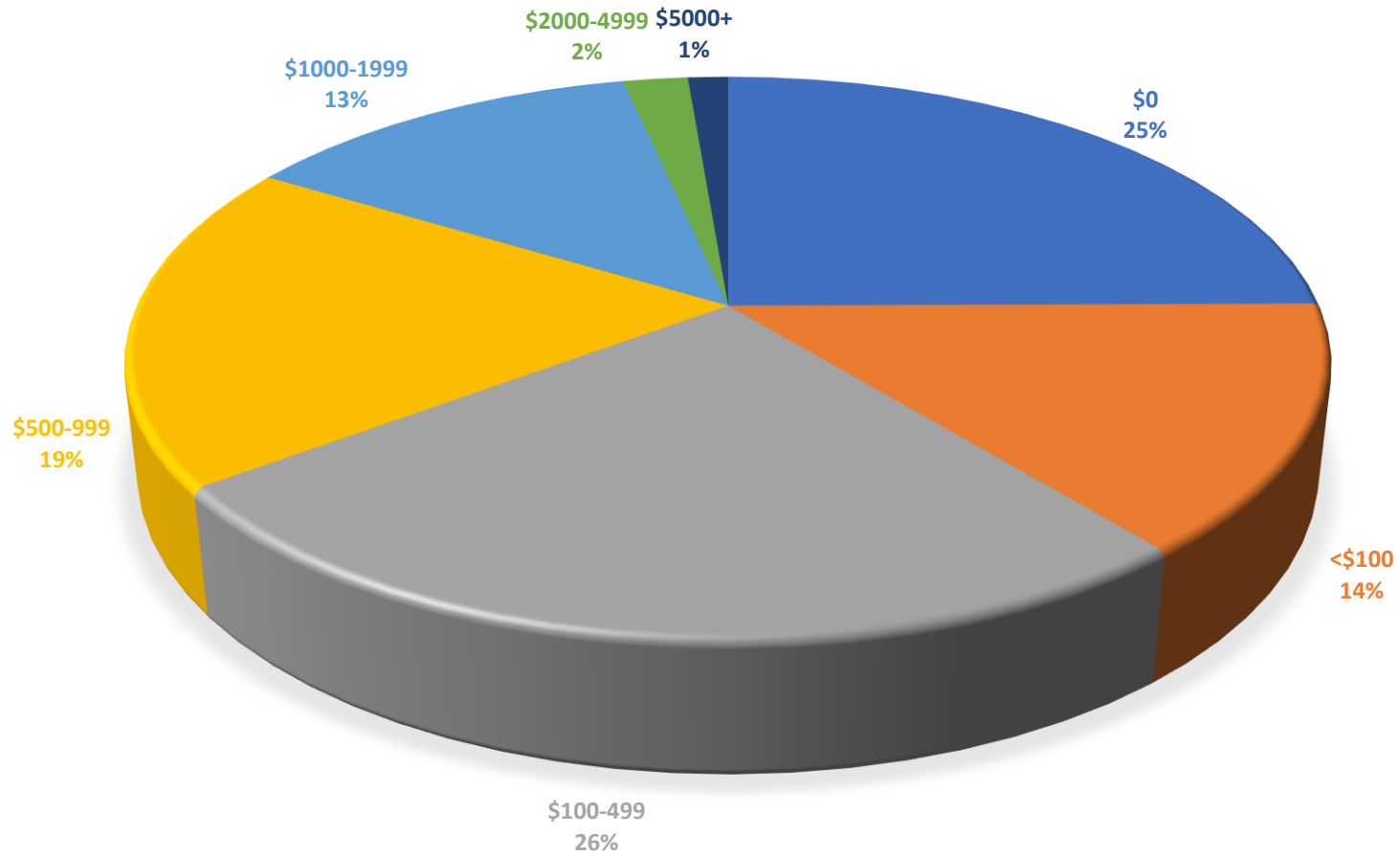
2b. Offertory Income per Parish per Year (Adjusted for Inflation)



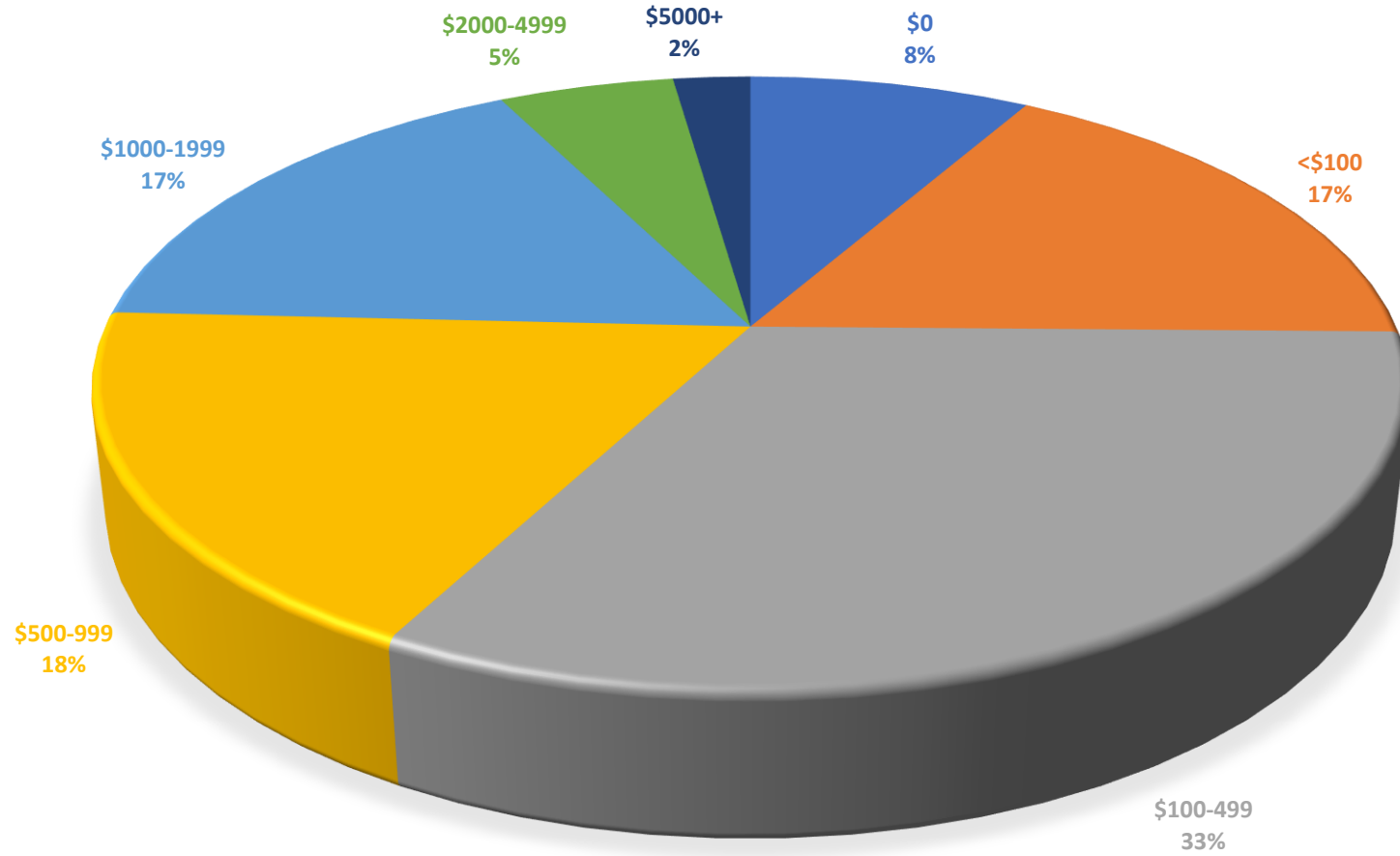
2c. Offertory Cohorts per Parish

ST. JOSEPH FAMILY OFFERTORY COHORTS, FISCAL 2018

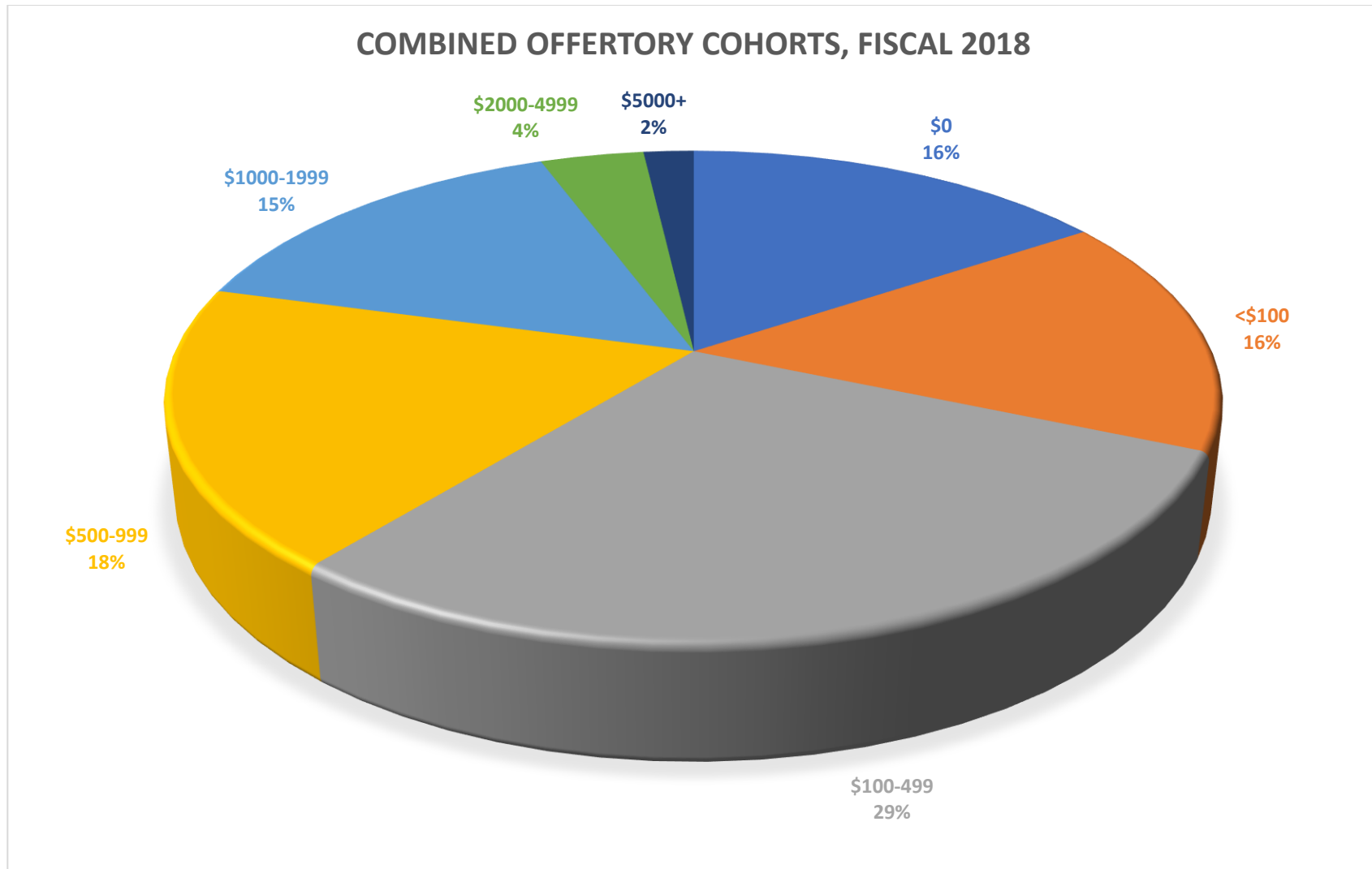


ST. STEPHEN FAMILY OFFERTORY COHORTS, FISCAL 2018
